Sole for spike shoes used in athletics, which sole is flexible (in 26) over most of its surface, and presents rigid bosses (28.1 to 28.6) holding in tapped collars (56) for screwing in spikes, and further comprising hollow protuberances (71 to 74; 91), characterized in that the protuberances are closed in such a way as to confine air in, said protuberances or pads being supple crushable.
