Abstract (en)  
[origin: EP0057355A2] 1. Hydraulic lifting apparatus containing a pump (1) with delivery flow adjustment 2), a hydraulic motor (piston-cylinder 6 or the like), lifting and lowering pipes (4, 20, 21, 22, 8, 17), and a control device (30 to 33) including valves (5, 14, 24, 28), characterised by the following features : a) the lifting and lowering pipes (4, 20, 21, 22, 8, 17) have a common pipe portion (between the points 40, 41) through which the flow is in the same direction and in which a proportionally acting throttle valve (5) is disposed ; b) the lowering pipe (20, 21, 22) is inserted into the common pipe portion, by way of a controllable shut-off valve (24), upstream (in the direction of flow) of the proportionally acting throttle valve (5) ; c) a return pipe (8, 17) is branched off from the common pipe portion, by way of a second shut-off valve (14), downstream (in the direction of flow) of the proportionally acting throttle valve (5).
