Abstract (en)  
[origin: EP0059869A1] 1. Weaver's beam for a warp yarn, with two principal beams flanges (2 and 3) immovably arranged on the beam tube (1) and two auxiliary beam flanges (4 and 5), characterised by the following features : a) the auxiliary beam flange (4) which serves to hold the wound-up warp yarn is slidably arranged on the beam tube (1), on the side of the principal beam flange (2) which faces the warp yarn, and the auxiliary beam flange (5) which also serves to hold the wound-up warp yarn is slidably located on the beam tube (1) on the side of the principal beam flange (3) which faces the warp yarn, b) for pressing the auxiliary beam flanges (4 and 5) against the wound-up warp yarn, spring elements (6) are arranged in a uniformly distributed manner at certain points between the principal beam flange (2) and the auxiliary beam flange (4) and between the principal beam flange (3) and the auxiliary beam flange (5), c) for temporarily holding the principal beam flange (2) and the auxiliary beam flange (4) together, and holding the principal beam flange (3) and the auxiliary beam flange (5) together, these flanges are provided with releasable holding devices (7) at certain points.
