Abstract (en)

An antitumor compound having the chemical structure <CHEM> or its acid addition salts is prepared by treating a compound <CHEM> wherein R is a COCH₃ or CH(OH)CH₃ group, with a streptomycetes strain or its mutants fostered from aclacinomycin producing organisms of mutation as Streptomyces galilaeus KE 303 (FERM-P 4808; ATCC 31649).
