Apparatus for attaching a grab (3) for agricultural buildings by means of a raising and lowering flexible traction means (4) to a movable support (trolley 25) especially a longitudinally movable trolley (25) on a guide such as a cross girder (24) of a hall travelling crane (23) characterised by a swiveling means (10, 11) provided at the grab (3) and its support (trolley 25) for automatic engaging and supporting the grab (3) on the support when reaching the lifting end position and by a swiveling means (12, 35, 36) for automatic upward swinging of the grab (3) from its hanging position into a lift position up to at least almost in a horizontal plane with the crane girder (24) and trasverse to the drive position of its support, respectively its trolley (25).
