Case frame for the covering of the edge of a wall opening intended for a door or the like, consisting of a filler (9) lying before the soffit (4 or 5) of the wall opening and U-shaped sheathings (7, 8) arranged at right angles on the edges of the filler and lying before the wall surfaces (3), where the sheathings possess, on their inner side (10) facing the wall surface, fastening dowels (12) protruding perpendicularly from the inner side and insertable into wall bores and the filler, consisting of a plate, is held fast on the sheathings by a filler fastening (17, 25, 22), and where the section flanges (14) of both sheathings (7, 8), facing the wall opening, protrude beyond the plane of the surface of the wall opening soffit (4 or 5) into the wall opening and the filler plate (9) set upon the section flanges (14) is supported with a spacing from the wall opening soffit (4 or 5), characterised in that the sheathings (7, 8), consisting of a thin-walled section, possess on the inner side of their section base (10) at least one rail (11) extending in the longitudinal direction of the section, in which rail the fastening dowels (12), formed with a thickened end received by the rail, are displaceable, in that the section flange (14) facing the wall opening is shaped by the sheathing (7) lying on the door rebate side of the case frame as rebate (20) for a door abutment, and in that the filler plate (9) rests only on the section flanges (14) of both sheathings (7, 8) facing the wall opening, for the spaced support from the wall opening soffit (4 or 5).
