Abstract (en)
[origin: WO8301896A1] A device for hydraulic massage comprising: (A) a spray enclosure consisting of a drainage hood (5) and a sump (8) and (B) at least one spray nozzle (9) controlled by coordinate guide (13). A patient is placed upon the readily deformable impact area (1) and is separated from direct contact with the working fluid. The patient support may consist of a flexible screen (2) in the form of a tensioned cable grid supported by a frame (3) on supports (4). The sump (8) may be bounded by a perforated draining partition (7) splitting off an additional compartment or reservoir (12) of the sump (8). Fluid drained into the sump (8) and the reservoir (12), if any, may be reused.
