Abstract (en)
The invention relates to climbing chocks and has for its objective to improve on the traditional wedge-shape chock to render it more effective in an irregular generally tapered crack whilst maintaining a high degree of effectiveness in a smooth sided crack. This objective is met by a construction comprising a generally wedge shaped body (1), a longitudinal side face (2) on the body, edge walls (3) on the body extending from each side of the side face and merging at a distance from the side face, said side face and said point where said edge walls merge being respectively convexly and concavely or respectively concavely and convexly curved in the longitudinal direction.
