Abstract (en)

A binder for retaining a plurality of sheets in a condition to be individually viewed comprising front and rear covers, front and rear staple covering sections hinged to the front and rear covers respectively along first fold lines, and front and rear staple receiving sections hinged to the front and rear staple covering sections respectively along second fold lines. Each of the staple receiving sections has an outer surface and an opposed inner surface against which a margin of the sheets is retained by staples extending through the margin of the sheets and the staple receiving sections with the staples being secured against the outer surfaces of the staple receiving sections.
