Abstract (en)

[origin: EP0160178A1] 1. A cleaning tool for picking up dirt from a floor surface, which can be moved back and forth by means of a guide rod articulated to its housing (1) and which comprises a rotating brush (4), driven by the back and forth motion, and dirt collecting chambers (7) arranged on both longitudinal sides of the rotating brush (4) in which the particles of dirt hurled up by the rotating brush (4) are collected, characterized in that the housing (1) is coupled to a suction socket (2) which can be attached to a suction pipe (3) which is connected or can be connected to a vacuum cleaner, that moreover the base (8) of the dirt collecting chambers (7) contains suction openings (9) which are covered by sealing elements (10) which open under the influence of the flow of air produced by the vacuum cleaner.
