Abstract (en)  
[origin: EP0173959A1] A sheet stacker includes a suction conveyor (6) disposed upwardly of a sheet-stacking table (8) and having a lower sheet-attracting surface for transferring the sheets (2) supplied from a sheet manufacturing machine (1), a sheet stopper (7) for stopping the advancing movement of the sheets transferred by said suction conveyor, and a sheet separator (12) operable in timed relation to the supply of the sheets from the previous processing station for separating the sheets successively from said suction conveyor so as to fall onto the sheet-stacking table.
