Abstract (en)  
[origin: EP0193817A2] The hair curler has an essentially cylindrically shaped curler body which has at its two end faces a device for attaching a strip-shaped holder which prevents the hair curler from becoming unwound. In order that they have the simplest possible construction, are easy to handle and are secured against unwinding in any desired curler position, the hair curlers are constructed in such a way that the device (2, 3) consists of an adhesion closure, one part (2) of the adhesion closure being arranged at the end faces of the hair curler (1) and the other part (3) on the surface of a strip (4). <IMAGE>
