Abstract (en)  
[origin: EP0274696A2] The attendant's seat (4), which is arranged next to the head end of a stretcher (3) or stretcher stage (2), can be adjusted steplessly between a low and a raised position (4', 4''), the seat (4) at the same time executing a movement in the longitudinal direction of the vehicle. In the raised and rearwardly displaced position (4''), the attendant can easily observe the head of the patient lying on the stretcher, without turning his head. The low and forwardly displaced position guarantees a high degree of comfort, and at the same time the patient can still be observed from the side. <IMAGE>
