Abstract (en)

[origin: EP0277610A2] The switch according to the invention has a contact pair whose contact ends touch one another in a sprung manner in the switched-on position. The contacts of a contact pair are jointly carried over into their respective switching positions, via cam projections, so that the switching paths of each contact end can be designed to be relatively small, without prejudice to maintenance of the required safety distances in the switched-off position. Between the contact ends, a spacer can be inserted which allows further circuits to be connected. <IMAGE>
