Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0280609A1] The anti-dazzle screen (1), intended to be fitted to central reservation barriers, consists of panels (1') each comprising an elongated base (2) resting on the top (40) of the barrier (4) and mounted beneath a masking plate (3) extending generally in the median plane of the barrier and having a succession of series of vertical panels (19-22) arranged in a broken horizontal straight line; one (22) of these panels is arranged as a window. The vertical edges of the panels (1') comprise projecting parts (12a, 12b, 13a) and complementary set-back parts (22a, 23a, 23b), it being possible for the adjacent edges of two juxtaposed panels thus to fit together. Each projection has a vertical passage (14, 15) of oblong cross-section, and a bar (16) of circular cross-section is passed through the aligned passages and fastened in a hole (18) in the top of the barrier (4). The base (2), which has a cross-section in the shape of an inverted U, comprises, at the bottom of this U (5), a groove (7) capable of receiving the upper edge of an underlying panel (1') if the panels (1') are placed on top of one another. <IMAGE>
