Abstract (en)  
[origin: EP0283930A1] In the shorts or short skirt with inner briefs, the shorts or short skirt and inner briefs are sewn together in the seam area to form a single unit. A process is also described in which the shorts or the short skirt and inner briefs are sewn to each other along a continuous seam transversal to the axis of the body, with corresponding seam areas and common stitching and separating areas, forming a double lining. Finally, individual parts are separated from the band and turned in towards each other on a flexible connecting piece. Application as a towel support for incontinent adults.
