[origin: EP0290658A1] In the wig, the hairs (2) are not linked facing forwards, but are arranged in an arched form on the underside of the edge zone (3) of the base member (1) and firstly face in the direction (4) towards the neck starting from the respective attachment point (5) of the hairs and then protrude forwards (6) from the base member after an arcuate reversal of direction. In this case, a particularly advantageous wearing effect of the base member is achieved as well as an optical impression as if the hairs emerge from the scalp "like real growth".
