Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0291080A2] Foldable display stands are used for the presentation of retail goods. In known display stands, which have inclined containers for the goods, the goods are only accessible from one side of the display stand. The new display stand is intended to allow goods situated in the containers to be accessible from two sides. In order to allow display of the goods on opposite sides of the display stand, there is arranged on the latter a second container (12) for goods which is arranged on the pulling tab of the top wall of the pedestal (3). The top edges of the side walls are each constructed rising towards one another in the manner of a gable. In the display position of the display stand (1), the top wall of the pedestal (3) rests on the top edges (13, 14) of the side walls in such a way that the two containers (2, 12) for goods are arranged on the pedestal (3) rising towards each other in the manner of a roof and each inclined towards the front wall (4) or rear wall (5) respectively. The display stand is suitable for displaying goods in sales rooms. It can be set up, in particular, alone or in a row of several display stands in the centre of wide sales passages.
