Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0310855A2] The self-supporting play area has a frame and consists of vertically extending posts which are in detachable connection with one another via horizontal beams and the beams are arranged in at least two planes 2, 3, extending with mutual spacing, and the beams 4, 5, extending perpendicular to one another, of one plane 2, 3 are offset in height approximately corresponding to their thickness. Furthermore, the beams 4, 5 engage in grooves situated in the posts 1, the depth of which grooves is less than the width of the beams 4, 5 and a platform 6 can be placed on the beams 4, 5 and the gaps 7, formed by the frame, are at least partially closed by detachably attached wall elements. <IMAGE>
