[origin: EP0327922A2] Known hinged attaché cases (1) have insufficient stability when placed upright. Furthermore, accessibility to the files is very limited. The hinged attaché case (1) is divided into a bottom part (8) and a top part (9, 10). The plane (7) of division of the side walls (2, 3) extends at a distance above the case bottom (4). The bottom part (8) is constructed as a stable, closed unit. The top parts (9, 10) are folded down when the case is opened. The attaché case (1) is provided for documents, papers and the like.
