[origin: WO8900485A1] A worker support particularly a mechanics creeper comprises a back support (10) on which a person lies in use in a supine position to enable the person to work in a space with a low vertical clearance, ground engaging wheels (34, 35) for engaging with the ground so that the back support (10) is generally level, the back support (10) having an extent along a generally longitudinal direction (A) along which the person's spine (20) in use lies, the back support (10) having sufficient rigidity to support the person's back along a substantial part of the length of the spine (20), and being shaped to support the person's back in a physiologically compatible posture so as to reduce undesirable spinal deformation.
