[origin: US5048090A] A hearing aid is described comprising a transmitter housing part and a microphone housing part associated with the external ear, together with associated actuating units and is characterized in that the microphone housing part is formed as a plastic hook or an at least partially elastically deformable unit adaptable individually to the curve of the concha, and in that the microphone is arranged in the end region remote from the transmitter housing part.
