[origin: EP0369239A2] In a sanitary mixing valve having at least two connections for the supply lines, and a separate quantity-regulating valve, it is proposed for the purpose of improvement and in particular for a multi-purpose, relatively simple sanitary installation that the mixing valve is connected to the quantity-regulating valve via at least one variable sanitation pipeline which is also constructed for holding additional equipment, and in each case a supply line connection is located at an in each case separate housing. <IMAGE>
