Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0373033A1] In this needle with an opening eye, intended to be used in the lacing stage of the three-dimensional weaving of a composite-reinforcement element, for driving out rigid rods and replacing them with loops of yarn, comprising an axial blind hole at its end adjacent to the eye, the bottom of the said hole (13) is open and connected to the outside by a channel (14) oblique relative to the axis of the shaft of the needle (8) and opening out laterally by way of an orifice (15) in the vicinity of the eye (12), between the latter and the end of the shaft. <IMAGE>
