Abstract (en)
[origin: US4971350A] A downhill ski has side walls which form, over at least a part of their length, an acute angle with the base and have a continuously varying slope and are asymmetrical. The slope angle of one of the side walls increases from tip to waist and decreases from waist to tail, while the slope angle of the other side wall decreases from tip to waist and increases from waist to tail. The two skis of a given pair are symmetrical to one another relative to a longitudinal plane located midway between the two skis, so that like side walls can be alternately positioned adjacent each other to suit different snow conditions. The construction provides enhanced versatility for varying snow conditions.
