[origin: EP0400358A1] The invention relates to a drinking glass (2) or the like having an upper part (4), which preferably consists of glass and is constructed, for example, as a chalice, and a preferably metal foot (8). In order to provide a drinking glass (2), in which the upper part (4) and the foot (8) are detachable, but are reliably joined to one another, provision is made for the upper part (4) to have a pin (6) and for the foot (8) to have a collet chuck (10) for the detachable attachment of the upper part (4) to the foot (8). <IMAGE>
