Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0415093A1] A pentagonal stone (1) is formed by cutting out from a square basic shape exactly one eighth of the overall surface, this cutout, at least on one side line (4) of the square, extending exactly as far as its centre and being rectilinearly delimited, and this cutout being alternatively a rectangle (2) or a right-angled isosceles triangle (3), one side line in each case accordingly also corresponding to half the length of the side lines (4) of the original square. <IMAGE>
