Abstract (en)
[origin: WO8912717A1] A method for the manufacture of a papermaker's fabric is proposed which involves the provision of a multiply fabric having fold regions (15, 16) at its respective ends and the removal of cross-machine direction yarns (14) in such fold regions thereby to create seam-forming loops (17, 18). The loops (17, 18) may be interdigitated directly to receive a pintle wire into engagement therewith and thus form a seam, or may receive a spiral for seam-forming purposes. The method is of application to flat-woven or endless woven structures, and is of use in the manufacture not only of papermaker's fabrics \$i(per se) but also in the manufacture of base materials for use therein.
