Abstract (en)

[origin: EP0426173A2] A rotary diamond dresser (1) for dressing a grinding wheel, includes a body (1) made of a sintered alloy, and a multiplicity of single crystal diamond pieces (2) embedded in the body in a circumferentially equally spaced relationship. These diamond pieces project radially from the outer peripheral surface of the body. The direction in which each diamond piece has resistance to wear is parallel to a line extending tangentially of the outer peripheral surface of the body so as to minimize the amount of wear during dressing operation.
