Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0432576A2] The sunshade has a shaft (10) which can be inserted into the ground or a stand. In order to accommodate a shelf for articles, the shaft (10) has, below the region occupied by the folded-in stretcher frame for the covering (14), a second stretcher frame having a number of supporting levers distributed around the shaft and mounted in an articulated manner which can be stretched into a radial position by means of struts attached thereto in an articulated manner and of a sliding sleeve which can be supported on the shaft, in which radial position they form a support for plate-shaped elements which combine to form a table (20). <IMAGE>
