Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0433099A1] The invention relates to a seat such as a couch, armchair or settee, which will be applied in particular by furniture manufacturers. <??>The invention concerns the conversion of seats with low aesthetic lines into comfortable seats. For this purpose, the back (3) of the seat (1) comprises articulated headrests (8) which can either be deployed vertically in order to provide a support zone for the whole of the back and a head rest for the occupant of the seat, or can be folded down against the back (3) in order to become retracted and comply with the aesthetic lines of the furniture. <IMAGE>
