[origin: JPH05168643A] PURPOSE: To provide an endoscope for urethra passing operation, which is capable of preventing irritation and damage to a urethra. CONSTITUTION: In an endoscope for urethra passing operation, which includes a main body 50 for integrally holding a lens system 51 and an operation instrument 52 and an external shaft 56 surrounding the lens system 51 and the operation instrument 52 in a pipe shape and connected to the main body 50, the external shaft 56 is provided so as to be rotated against the other remaining part of the endoscope.
