[origin: EP0514278A1] The invention relates to a shoe hanger intended to serve as a display device in shops, more especially in department stores, supermarkets, hypermarkets or specialised shops, for facilitating the sale of this type of article. <??>The shoe hanger (1) comprises a central rod (5) ending in a suspension hook (3), and two lateral eyelets (6, 7) over which the shoes (2) are slipped. <??>According to the invention, as the shoes are connected by a flexible link (8) of the fine steel cable or polyamide thread type, the shoe hanger comprises means (14) for joining, by means of the said link, the central rod to the assembly consisting of the shoes (2) and the flexible link (8).
