Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0521332A1] In a multi-layer label for sticking onto containers, the space for any information to be given can be increased by intermediate sheets (3) and reading can be facilitated preferably by the fact that the cover sheet (4) has a tear-off perforation (7) not only at its bonded right-hand edge region (5), but that the cover sheet (4) and the intermediate sheet (3) have tear-off perforations (13; 14) in the left-hand bonded edge region (8), by means of which perforations the sheets (3; 4) can be removed. <IMAGE>
