[origin: WO9215319A1] The invention relates to HIV protease inhibitors wherein the compounds have a 2,4-dihydroxy isostere wherein the hydroxyl group in the 2-position is further substituted to create a tertiary alcohol. Also disclosed are pharmaceutically acceptable salts thereof, which inhibit HIV-I protease and are useful in the treatment of AIDS.
