Abstract (en)  
[origin: EP0579135A2] The invention relates to a cabinet with a shelf rack drawer which is held and guided in a manner secure against tilting underneath its base on both sides by in each case one vertically mounted telescopic extension with roller or, in particular, ball guidance and, furthermore, exhibits improved transverse rigidity in the fully extended state by means of a horizontal telescopic extension 16 with ball guidance. Vertical adjusting screws 13, which can be screwed into an L-angle connected to the movable part of the vertical telescopic extensions and situated under the base 3 of the shelf rack drawer, permit an infinitely variable height and inclination adjustment of the shelf rack drawer relative to the body of the cabinet. In the upper region, the shelf rack drawer carries, symmetrically to its vertical mid-plane, a running strip 22 which is guided by two opposite rollers 24 with vertical axes of a fitting 27 fixed in the front region of the construction base of the cabinet. The measures according to the invention improve the transverse rigidity, resistance to tilting and running stability and permit infinitely variable inclination adjustment and full extension of the shelf rack drawer. <IMAGE>
