Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0586956A1] The invention "multipack in the form of a carrier which is open at the top, in particular for forming a display box" relates to a carrier (1) having one or two carrier plates (2, 3) which form openings (5, 5', 47; 6, 7) to form receptacles for storing the products of the multipack (100). To form at least some of these receptacles and apertures (5, 5', 47; 6, 7), in this case apertures (21) in the form of punch-outs of the cardboard blank are formed at least in the upper carrier plate (2), which apertures are provided with an aperture rim (11, 11') to protect the individual products (10, 10'). Said aperture rim is placed over a peripheral section (42) of the carrier plate (2) and shaped at that point with an upper beading (12, 12') which slopes down into the carrier (1) on the inside and tapers to a given minimum aperture cross-section corresponding to the cross-section of the product (10, 10') at that point, which beading is continued downwards by an adjacent crease (49) and flap pieces (28, 48) with or without an additional lower beading (13, 13') and is bent laterally radially outwards, thus resulting in an aperture cross-section which widens outwards whilst forming a laterally projecting guide section or resilient flap pieces for the section of the inserted products (10, 10') to be removed. In this case, the beadings (12, 12'; 13, 13') are produced by twofold hot cardboard forming. In this case, the invention also relates to a method for producing a carrier with such receptacles formed by hot cardboard forming of the apertures. <IMAGE>
