Abstract (en)

A shoe support (1) for supporting a lasted shoe, bottom uppermost, has two spaced apart support members (20,22,44,46;24,26,50,52) for supporting a shoe therebetween. Each support member is mounted for pivotal movement about an associated support shaft (16;18) so as to enable the spacing between shoe-supporting surface portions (46;52) of the members to be varied. Resilient means (56), preferably a tension spring (56), serves to urge the surface portions (46;52) together to a position of minimum distance therebetween.
