Abstract (en)

[origin: EP0605730A1] A cloth having a desired printed pattern formed by dotted dyeing, on which said dotted dyeing is made to a length of 0.05-0.3 mm in the lengthwise direction of each monofilament of the threads constituting the cloth, a delicate printed pattern being also dyed clearly with a high reproducibility. This printed pattern can be formed by using dyes of three primary colors or three primary colors and a jet-black. These dyes of three primary colors preferably consist of dyes I, II, III in which the perceptual chromaticity indexes a, b defined in a hue range (CIE 1976 (L, a, b) space) on a cloth are in the following ranges, and a jet-black dye a dye IV. I Yellow: (a) -20 - 0 (b) 50 - 90; II Red: (a) 50 - 70 (b) 0 - 20; III Blue: (a) -50 - -10 (b) -50 - -20; IV Black: (a) -6 - 6 (b) -6 - 6. Such a printed cloth is obtained by dyeing the surface of a cloth with printing ink applied thereto in a dotted manner by means of a dye ejector provided with a nozzle of not lower than 80 dots/cm and controlled on the basis of an image signal.
