Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0627526A1] The approximately vertical side walls (2) of the paving stone (1) are inwardly offset in their lower part (6) with respect to the upper part (7) of the side wall (2). In this way, upon setting the paving stones (1) against one another, a cavity (8) which is open at the bottom results between two adjacent paving stones (1) in the lower part of the side walls (2). The communication of the cavities (8), interconnected in the manner of a drainage system, with the surface of the paving stones laid virtually without gaps is established by a vertical recess (9) in the upper part of the side walls (2) of the paving stones (1). Rapid and reliable drainage of the rainwater into the soil is thereby made possible. <IMAGE>
