Abstract (en)
[origin: EP0630593A1] The insole consists of a thin base plate 1, the surface of which is densely knobbed. Arranged between the knobs are breathing openings 9. Fastened preferably detachably on the base plate 1 are magnet heads 3. In the region of these magnet heads 3, the base plate 1 has a thickening 5. This thickening 5 with a halo-shaped surface 4 is not knobbed. The thickening 5 is raised at least to the level of the tops of the knobs 2. Such an insole, which overall has a thickness of only approximately 3 mm, can be worn in all commercially available shoes and boots. The insole can particularly advantageously also be used in sports shoes. <IMAGE>
