Abstract (en)
[origin: WO9400477A1] Compounds and methods of making them having formula (I) are described which bind to selectin receptors and thus modulate the course of inflammation, cancer and related diseases by modulating cell-cell adhesion events. In formula (I), R1 is independently H or lower alkyl(1-4C); R2 is H, OH or lower alkyl(1-4C), alkylaryl or one or more additional saccharide residues; R3 is a negatively charged moiety including SO₄⁻, PO₄⁻, or related group; Y is H or lower alkyl(1-4C); and X is -CHR₄(CHR₁)₂CHR₅OR₁ wherein R₄ and R₅ are each independently H, lower alkyl(1-4C), or taken together result in a five- or six-membered ring optionally containing a heteroatom selected from the group consisting of O, S, and NR₁; said five- or six-membered ring optionally substituted with one substituent selected from the group consisting of R₁, CH₂OR₁, OR₁, OOCR₁, NR₁₂, NHCOR₁, and SR₁ with the proviso that if X represents a hexose substituent R₃ and R₄, taken together, cannot provide a hexose substituent.

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
