Abstract (en)

In a pair of replaceable blade type scissors having a handle portion (2) and a blade portion (3) which are freely connectable and disconnectable, a plurality of fitting apertures (5) are provided in one of overlapping portions (4) (9) of the handle portion (2) and the blade portion (3), a plurality of protruding members (10) are provided to the other overlapping portion (9), and the plurality of the fitting apertures (5) and the plurality of the protruding members (10) are fitted, respectively, so that the handle portion (2) and the blade portion (3) are coupled to each other. Since the fitting apertures (5) and the elastically deformable protruding members (10) are fitted at a plurality of separate positions, unsteadiness between the handle portion (2) and the blade portion (3) is positively prevented. At this time, since tolerances in the positions and dimensions of the fitting apertures (5) and the protruding portions (10) are absorbed by the elastic deformation of the protruding members (10), machining accuracy of these parts is not necessarily increased so much. <IMAGE>
