[origin: EP0884075A2] A double goal, for use in sport or as a toy, comprises symmetrically arranged goal frames (1, 2) and side rebound members (3). The frame preferably comprises horizontal bars (2) and posts (1). The posts preferably form part of the rebound members. The rebound members preferably comprise a transparent material, e.g. plastic, perspex, etc..
