Abstract (en)

[origin: DE19631372A1] A storage device for storing bottles items, such as mineral water, beer and wine bottles or the like, principally in a horizontal position inside the storage space of a piece of furniture, such as a refrigerator, food cupboard, shelf or similar, has a section fixed in the area of the edge of the storage space of the piece of furniture and a swivelling section joined by a hinge to the first section. The swivelling element has a holding element for the bottles items. In its position allowing the storage of the bottles items, the swivelling section swivels into the free storage space of the piece of furniture. When it is not in use, the swivelling section can swivel back out of the storage space.
