[origin: DE19641691A1] The invention relates to novel substituted 2-amino-4-alkylamino-1,3,5-triazines of formula (I), in which R<1> stands for respectively optionally substituted alkyl with 2 to 6 carbon atoms or cycloalkyl with 3 to 6 carbon atoms, R<2> stands for hydrogen or alkyl with 1 to 4 carbon atoms, A for oxygen or methylene, Ar for respectively optionally substituted phenyl, naphthyl or heterocycyl, and Z for hydrogen, for halogen or for respectively optionally substituted alkyl, alkoxy, alkylcarbonyl, alkoxy carbonyl, alkylthio, alkylsulfinyl, alkylsulfonyl, alkenyl or alkynyl, methods and new intermediate products for their production and their use as herbicides.
