[origin: DE19654468C1] The invention relates to a method for producing an extremely flexible dermally or transdermally acting plaster with an adhesive matrix layer containing an active ingredient, which has, on the side facing the skin, a removable protective layer. Said method is characterized in that the matrix layer is not covered on the side facing away from the skin but that its open surface is not made adhesive.
