Abstract (en)
[origin: WO9915087A1] Method and device for surgical joining the small intestine and the rectum. After the large intestine has been removed from the small intestine, the mucosa, a part of the small intestine, is prepared in such a manner that it is free. This is achieved by introducing a tube which is curved through approximately 20 DEG and has a length of approximately 20 cm into the small intestine. The mucosa and submucosa is removed from the rectum and then the curved tube, with the freed small intestinal mucosa on it, is introduced into the rectum. These parts are then joined together and the tube is removed via the anus.
