Abstract (en)  
[origin: DE19820138A1] The invention relates to a housing module (14, 14', 15, 15'), preferably for a prefabricated building, comprising a space (32, 32') having a base plate (30) which is made of a mineral building material and can be used as floor or ceiling, and side walls (18, 19, 20) which are mounted on and joined laterally on said base plate (30) and which extend vertically in relation to the base plate and delimit the space (32, 32') along the sides. The housing module (14) is characterized in that the space (32, 32') is open to the top and the side walls (18, 19, 20) delimit the space (32, 32') on no more than three sides. The invention also relates to a building part (48), preferably for a prefabricated building (16), comprising at least one housing module (14, 14', 15, 15'). The invention further relates to a method for producing such a housing module (14, 14', 15, 15') and to a method for producing a building part (48), preferably for a prefabricated building (16), comprising several such housing modules (14, 14', 14", 15, 15').
