[origin: US6910222B1] A textile includes a plurality of individual elements of material with each of the plurality of individual elements having a given shape, with the given shape of one of the individual elements being either the same or different from one or more other individual elements. A plurality of segments of material are placed on at least one of the individual elements with adjacent segments of the plurality of segments being formed with complementary shapes to one another. The plurality of segments are able to be connected to at least one of the individual elements in either a non-detachable or detachable manner.
